The ADT Surveyor 2000 is considered to be the leading dome camera of its class. With a five inch diameter and smooth silent operation, it offers a truly unobtrusive security solution. The Surveyor 2000 is available in a range of housings, allowing the cameras to be mounted internally and externally. The external Surveyor 2000 unit is fitted with a sunshield, blower and heater to ensure that images remain clear.

CCTV – Dome Cameras

The Surveyor 2000 is available in Colour and Monochrome and the Colour/Mono version is fitted with a high quality 23:1 zoom lens. The lens is one of the largest available within a dome camera, allowing the operator to view a person over 95 metres away, whilst still reaching the requirements of the the Police Scientific Development Board (PSDB) for recognition. Dome cameras allow operators maximum control over CCTV systems. Domes are a one unit solution which comprise a Camera, Lens and Pan and Tilt Motors. As technology has advanced these units have become smaller and less obtrusive.



The Surveyor 2000 Domes will work from 0.25° per second up to 300° per second which will give the operator much more dexterity over the movement of the camera. Using smoothed variable speed systems makes it easier for the operator to follow a subject. High speed rotation also allows the unit to turn automatically to a pre-set position very quickly, therefore capturing vital images.

Pre-set positions are 'fields of view' that the camera has stored in its memory, for example, a view of an entrance door or loading bay area. The Surveyor 2000 can automatically turn to these pre-set positions from an input i.e. a door opening or an intruder detector activating. Pre-sets allow the system to be automated which can save vital seconds of image capture. The Surveyor 2000 has 79 pre-sets, enough to cover every area within the camera's range.

The Surveyor 2000 has ten tours, allowing it to patrol an area automatically, two of these are self learn tours, which can be easily programmed by the operator. The camera remembers which movements the operator makes and stores them as a tour. The Surveyor 2000 also has a real-time clock which can be used to run up to 64 time driven events, such as alarm activation/deactivation, preset or tour call. These can be set to daily, weekly or specific days.



The Surveyor 2000 is one of the most versatile, far reaching and inconspicuous cameras of its kind, giving you a high class observation and the ability to preset the cameras to view problem areas.
